I encourage people to look at the Practicing the Way website (www.practicingtheway.org). All of the resources are free, including an online eight-session series that covers all of the Practicing the Way basics. This looks at practicing the Way of Jesus from an evangelical Protestant perspective.

For a mainline Protestant perspective check out the Practicing Our Faith website (www.practicingourfaith.org). The point of these websites, and the books associated with them, is to help people put their faith into practice.

I've used Practicing Our Faith resources at several congregations in the last twenty years. The Practicing the Way model is more recent. At the core of these models is an understanding that discipleship is a practice. In the words of John Mark Comer, we want to "Be with Jesus," "Become like Jesus," and "Do as Jesus did"
